 gave him 35 cts We harrowed some in No 1  
 green crop land with Williams harrows then we  
 cultivated and harrowed No 5 creek side.

 \$2.88 paid with them balance on boots got on 5th 2.20  
 got shirt 75 cts got lines mended galleon & snafes at  
 Woodens 40 cts pattern at Russell's 15 cts he brought  
 up 7 & 8 M took them down again P.M. I sowed rest  
 of black snuck 2 of No 3 O.A.C No 3 also NW piece  
 of No 4 bush O.A.C No 3 next bush I ambery next  
 road seeded with sweet clover. P.M. we worked in No 5 got  
 some of the under foanette out sowed. A sheep had 2 lambs to-day  
 we let the sheep with older lambs out to grass to-day. Willie got
