Sun Jul 7<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cool.  
 Mon Jul 8<sup>th</sup> light clouds and pleasant. I sawing and splitting wood in the fore noon after noon not working was up last night with Eliza Snary who is very sick  
 Tue July 9<sup>th</sup> clear and warm. was down to Bilton's last night and part of the day  
 Wed Jul 10<sup>th</sup> clear most of the day and hot was cutting weed in the garden  
 Thu Jul 11<sup>th</sup> clear and pleasant. I was down to my Brother Bilton's his wife died this morning. I done nothing the rest of the day  
 Fri July 12<sup>th</sup> clear and cool part of the day Mrs Boyington of B Snary's. not doing anything myself  
 Sat Jul 13<sup>th</sup> clear and pleasant. about noon I went anything but attend the funeral of Brother Bilton's wife

ELIZA SNARY WIFE DIED

Sun Jul 14<sup>th</sup> clear and hot attended church Albert Ward preached we got sad news this morning that Merion Ellice was found Dead in bed  
 Mon Jul 15<sup>th</sup> clear and 100 deg. doing but little  
 Tue Jul 16<sup>th</sup> cloudy a light thunder shower this afternoon. was to the burial of Merion Ellice this Evening  
 Wed Jul 17<sup>th</sup> clear most of the day and hot. 100 deg in the shade at 3 P M. I went down to the old place in the fore noon for the sprinkler and sprinkled the potatoes Mrs Boyington went to the Burg  
 Thu Jul 18<sup>th</sup> clear and hot I was bathing to day  
 Fri Jul 19<sup>th</sup> clear and hot. not doing much. Setting in the house most of the day  
 Sat Jul 20<sup>th</sup> clear and hot 98 deg in shade at 2:30 P M. not doing anything  
 Sun Jul 21<sup>st</sup> cloudy and hot I was at church  
 Mon Jul 22<sup>nd</sup> clear and not so hot as it has been high wind from the North. I was down to the old place cleaning the last of my wheat
