


March 1892

- 7 20 Very stormy, none out of the village in church. Not one single sun all day
- 8 21 Our Royal Templars went to Barry Hill Council to visit was 4 P.M. when they left Mrs. Slack paid \$4.00
- 9 22 Angus Phillips has a sale today Hatty came to visit her cousin brought her. Got 2 1/2 lbs butter
- 10 23 Bird & Hatty went to visit St. Donald Roy's drove Hatty Assessor here
- 11 24 Fine day not very cold Miss Urquhart paid \$2.00 I made a small washing
