- Aug 1st. Performed Statute Labor on Side-road drew cinders from the

- 3rd Drove over to Brill for Sunday School for tea.
- 4th Went with Simons to Mr. Foreshaw's funeral in the afternoon.
- 5th Helped W. McPherson & Rye crofts to thresh.
- 6th Helped Simons to thresh Rye in the field.
- 7th Finished cutting oats in back 10 acre field & put the bind
- 8th Drew in mixed grain off 3 acre field 3 1/2 loads & drew manure to the ^{lawn}
- 9th Wm. Henderson came to thresh the wheat 3 1/2 bus off 14 acre field. Annie Williamson & Louise Hewitt came for a visit.
- 11th Finished drawing in Early Oats & mixed grain 6 1/2 loads off creek field.
- 12th Went to H. Cummingsham's Threshing. A fine rain at night
- 13th after several weeks of very dry weather.
- 14th Helped Johnsons & Bob Atkin to thresh. Finished threshing at Hartleys, another fine rain in the morning.
