13 Both finished plowing opposite B<sup>r</sup> C's A<sup>m</sup>  
I went to W<sup>m</sup> Burkholder's Sale P<sup>m</sup>. Joe began  
plowing turnip ground P<sup>m</sup>. W. very cold. freezing  
14 Joe plowed a little this morning. had to quit  
frost too hard then he drew sawed wood into  
shed. I didn't do much. have had cold  
moved stores this morning. W. very cold. day  
Sunday 15 at home. B<sup>r</sup> D's were here. B<sup>r</sup> N's & C B's  
were here P<sup>m</sup>. W. Clear. milder  
16 I & Nancy & little boys went to D<sup>r</sup> H<sup>r</sup> Rains  
17 Joe thrashed few Peas this morning <sup>W. fine clear cold good</sup> then both plowed  
in turnip land. W. a little rain this morning foggy  
18 Both plowed awhile A<sup>m</sup>. <sup>through the day</sup> Joe plowed P<sup>m</sup>  
I didn't do much P<sup>m</sup>. Red Jos Barkers were  
here awhile. then I went to John Cobbs this evening  
for some tar to fumigate my head. got a bad  
cold. W. pretty cold. rather cloudy  
19 Joe helped J D's kill hogs. I chored J B's sawed  
wood for my Mother I helped a little & we fixed  
Cow manges. & Jumper's fixed Cistern Pump  
& front Pump. my cold is better. W. Cloudy  
20 Chored & Cleaned gut A<sup>m</sup> I took it to M<sup>r</sup>  
& Joe thrashed Peas P<sup>m</sup> W. about 2 inches snow  
last night & A<sup>m</sup>. tied up Cattle last night  
21 Fixed things round stables ready for  
winter brought home yearling Colt from B<sup>r</sup> C's  
A<sup>m</sup> Cleaned Peas & Joe took them to mill &  
I made ready for killing Pigs on Monday. P<sup>m</sup>  
W. rather mild. snow not gone yet  
Sunday 22 at home. W. blustering. & a little snow from  
23 Killed our 7 hogs. W. same last night <sup>east P<sup>m</sup></sup> cloudy today  
some rain & soft snow this evening

Nov. 24 I went to B<sup>r</sup> C's this <sup>14.74</sup> morning <sup>near to help kill hogs weather</sup>  
to stormy came home & fixed things in shop Joe thrashed  
Peas. W. snow from west heavy wind this morning a little heavy  
I & little John brought home Peas Chop this evening  
25 I & Nancy helped B<sup>r</sup> C kill hogs Joe plowed  
W. fine. no frost in ground. about an inch snow  
26 I & Nancy helped A B's kill hogs. W. fine. mild  
27 I went to old W. Morrison's A<sup>m</sup> Cleaned out the  
drains & enlarged little Orchard P<sup>m</sup> Joe finished  
plowing & water furrowing turnip ground A<sup>m</sup>  
28 Made sheep rack & temporary bars between  
old barn & driving house. W. soft snow nearly  
Sunday 29 I & Nancy went to Funeral of <sup>all day</sup> Russian  
Mennonites Child at Cedar Grove. I think I forgot  
to mention that six families of Mennonites are  
staying in Markham over winter they arrived  
in Toronto rather late to go to Manitoba  
several families are living in Uncle Sam's  
Reesor's house one of their children was  
present today sermon by B<sup>r</sup> C on 71<sup>st</sup> Psalm  
23 W. W. about six in snow last night. tough  
30 Joe flailed Oats A<sup>m</sup> & Peas P<sup>m</sup> I & Nancy  
went to Whitewalk P<sup>m</sup> rough sleighing pretty cold  
Deer. I Joe thrashed Peas A<sup>m</sup>. & took gut Oats to  
B<sup>r</sup> D's P<sup>m</sup>. W. some snow. Mild  
2 Joe drew home cordwood out of old bush A<sup>m</sup>  
went to C Cooks wood on P<sup>m</sup> I didn't do much  
have sore throat. W. fine mild snow going  
3 I done nothing. Joe went to Funeral of P<sup>r</sup> H<sup>r</sup>  
Spence A<sup>m</sup> Cut wood in old bush P<sup>m</sup>  
I done nothing my throat very sore. W. snow  
4 Joe drew dung to bank <sup>near by</sup> <sup>all gone</sup> <sup>later a m</sup>  
his time is up at noon today W. very fine clear  
5 I chored. W. Mild. Cloudy. my throat is pretty sore  
Sunday 6 I & boys went to Meeting at Babron  
remarks by B<sup>r</sup> C sermon on  
David Hooper <sup>he</sup> conducted a short service at my  
mother's P<sup>m</sup>. W. mild cloudy snow nearly gone
