Fine sunny day warm. Frost last night
We worked in No 5 to-day sowed rest of block
from the oats set a 2 bushels to acre then
sowed O.A.C. 12 (which we treated with
formalin) set at 3 bushels then 3 1/2. We
cultivated twice harrowed twice. got No 5
more than half sowed. 3 more acres & 2 sheep.

Sunday

Cloudy day raining at noon ^{PM} and at night
at intervals. Our Anniversary. Rev Mr
Knox of London preached AM from Jno 1:29
and in evening to united congregation of
and Methodists from Amos 5:18 a sermon on
Mary at home all day. Ross Milne here now, waiting to go
to Ottawa to enlist. We gave Anniversary coll girls \$100 Mrs \$200

Heavy rain last night. Thunder & lightning, rained
2 05 this morning. lots of farmers have not sowed any
grain yet this season has been so wet. I drove
down in morning took 4 doz eggs to 7 & 84cts
got 25 lbs flour 85cts got tooth treated at Arthurs
deposited money in R B got sewing machine needles
at R Craigs 10cts ripple at Phillips 10cts meat at
Shoemaker \$1.10 Willie got manure spreader out
PM we spread 8 loads on No 1 N E filling up
spaces at fence etc 4 hours. Willie started to plow
3 10 there also. I got Wm Maywood to phone to C.P.R. re entering
harrow after dinner. Rabbit come. Willie chopped some
