Jess Bowley got oats \$1.90 paid \$1.00 on them Fred Bowley got oats 664 lb. Jno Knox up working in garden in AM paid him 25 cts for seed potatoes. Willie down town at night sent catalogue of White set bought caustic 10 lemons 5.
