Inguinal Hernia in Childhood.

Remember that in infants it is possible to obtain a spontaneous cure by maintaining continuous reduction by means of a truss, but after the second year the chances of cure by this method are doubtful. At this time, however, surgical treatment is eminently satisfactory and restores normal conditions at once. The rule then should be fairly uniform: (a) In infants apply a truss continuously as soon as the hernia is diagnosed. (b) After the second year consider radical operation if the nutritional index is favorable.—W. F. Campbell; *Med. Record.*
