Tuesday forward

Fine warm sunny day. Willie plowed 4 horses Perm plow No 1 in A.M. I skinned dead sheep cut wood etc. In P.M. Willie took Seamstress sewing machine got from Eaton on trail to station to ship back to Dorado then brought up load manure from Jim's which I spread and he brought up another. I went up to Browns with Lucy in buggy to see thrashers but they were not there. Then went down town sold sheep skin to H. Mills & Co. posted 2 letters one to Eaton re machine one to Reynolds. Willie got at cold storage meat and land 95cts

Wednesday

Fine sunny day. We took sheep and lambs down to scales in morning separated 17 lambs sold to ~~1570~~ lbs at 6cts Black and Shortnead 1570 lbs at 6cts \$94.00 weighing 30 Willie plowed sod No 2 rest of day. I worked at cellar drain in P.M.

Fine day cloudy breezy. Thanksgiving day Willie Mary and I went to Melville church in A.M. Mr Mullam preached Thanksgiving sermon from Heb. 9: 4. about the Pot of Manna. Mr Wright officiated Mr McVicar being in Alma preaching there. We gave Cole \$1.50. We all got dinner at home Auntie came home from West last night. Jim Fernal up in P.M. topping turnips we got 2 loads in. We laid some more tiles in cellar drain. Bell got on 13 at Stab's dry goods \$2.91 at Merrim's black lead and hooks 15cts
