The Relation of the Tonsils to Rheumatism.

Paul Roethlisberger calls attention in the Münchener Medizinische Wochenschrift for February 20 to the importance of the tonsils as an etiological factor in acute and subacute recurrent polyarthrititis and frequently of primary articular rheumatism. He advises careful digital examination of the tonsils and radical operation if the rheumatic condition does not improve rapidly. In many cases the tonsils contain encapsulated abscesses which should be opened.—*Med. Stand.*
