Wed Apr 12<sup>th</sup> clear and pleasant. I walked out to John Mc. Butchers this morning for a setting of white Wyandott eggs when I got home Bilton was there with a setting of Plymouth Rock eggs from Henry Sampmans. the assessor was here this after noon.

Thu Apr 13<sup>th</sup> clear and pleasant. I was digging the garden. Sarah came and helped me to set a hen

Fri Apr 14<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cool drizzling snow most the fore noon. Sarah was here baking and cleaning house. I done a little digging

Sat Apr 15<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cold snow showers through the day. Bilton was here part of the fore noon. I was digging a little in the garden

Sun Apr 16<sup>th</sup> snow and hail showers all day and cold

Mon Apr 17<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cold. Bilton called in this fore noon. I set a hen on wyandott eggs this fore noon

Tue Apr 18<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cool about an inch of snow on the ground this morning I set on in the house all day I Lashbrook was in a few minutes this after noon

Wed Apr 19<sup>th</sup> clear part of the day. Strong wind from South West. I finished digging the garden. Sarah was over this morning

Thu Apr 20<sup>th</sup> cloudy and moderate. rain about 3 Pm Annetie and Elva Paul was here about noon
