7 rest last night cloudy day some sunshine ground white with snow, snowed again in evening slushy. I plowed sod No 2 in A M and Willie took 6 fat chickens 36 lbs @ 9 ct \$3.24 to Armstrongs on apr. postage 4 In P M J. F and W B who were at Wm Hamilton in A M came and we got in 5 loads turnips. road getting very bad.

30

Tuesday

Cold wintry day cloudy snowing more snow last night frosty. Willie took straw down load to J. Armstrong living in A M and to J. Quinn in P M took 1280 lbs pig soap to Cantons in A M brought it up in P M 60 cts J F and W B up to-day throwing back turnips in root house etc. I put back chaff and got head power uncovered etc

31

Wednesday

Very frosty day cloudy in A M sunny in P M thawing in sun. Willie plowed sod No 2 in A M I went in buggy up to Archie Monro then down town and up to Mrs Blacks to see cattle. In P M we dug out turnips put with scraper and brought over two loads turnips left last stuck in road. Girls went down in buggy in evening took rooster and two lbs butter to Auntie to take to Toronto to-morrow I saw electric balloon they put up in American city in evening. Father up in morning.
