Surgical Hints.

Evidence is accumulating that fractures of the femoral neck, which formerly were believed to occur almost exclusively in aged persons, are not infrequent in children or adolescents. Cases of sprains in the region of the hip in young persons, if at all severe, should be carefully examined with the view of determining the possible presence of a fracture of the neck of the femur with the aid of the x-ray.—*Int.
