

the Island to another  
Bridge across the Banana  
River. It was  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile long  
these rivers are all salt  
water here and rise &  
fall with the tide. The  
country is small islands  
~~but~~ mostly water & swamps.  
The toll to cross this bridge  
was 40 ¢ then about another  
10 miles to Canaveral Harbor  
over rough & Sandy roads  
when the boom was on  
they had built sidewalks  
and put up electric lights  
for miles out from Canaveral  
now the lights are broken

on arrival there we found  
about 2 houses and a  
restaurant, and a wharf  
out on piles about 100 feet  
into the ocean. also  
found out we could not  
buy any bait to fish with  
we were to buy 5 crabs  
they catch them there  
but the sea had been  
rough and no fishing  
boats out for two weeks  
past. so no fishing.  
on the way back we  
stopped at Cocoa Beach  
a big hotel there but  
nothing in it but a  
Restaurant in one corner  
for fishermen I guess.  
The City hall & Chamber  
of Commerce shut up  
tight. then back
