- Fri Feb 3. Milder and thawing in Toronto at Hupp. Annie here at night. Mrs Powsell and Miss Edey called when I was away.
- Sat Feb 4. Mild and sloppy turned colder at night. Annie at Mrs Boyles to dinner. Mrs Davidson and I for a walk.
- Sun Feb 5. Fine bright perfect day. quite cold. at morning church. Mrs Davidson and I for a walk. I went to evening church. very cold.
