- 1 We got home the sheep Bird did not go to school today, and we made a large washing I am pretty well and have my head uncovered. the first time in three weeks, Mercury, was this morning above zero
- 2 Got Bird a pair books at Hill's 1.75 lovely day. Pa & Far in bush. A good Temperance meeting last night. Far & Jim were there, Jinnie a Roman lamb cup at Hill's 8.00
- 3 Got the money from J. H. M. Gallenoy. that Donco paid 5.95
- 4 I baked today, and my head and teeth are pretty sore
- 5 Sent a letter & paper to Sandy. the paper had a picture of the ice palace.
- 6 Very fine day beginning to thaw
- 7 Last evening John M Bairn was here. Jim & Bird were at prayer meeting. I could not go Jinnie & Ran went to the Lancaster factory and got the cloth 2 1/2 yds - pulling & darning cost 2.15. (got it from Far) They went to trim the trousers and gave them means to make Ran's pants. Got at M. Crummin's 6 oz pringery yarn 60¢ spool 10 = 70
- 8 Friday Lillie M Donald & Daisy were here last evening to tea. Then they went to the debate I got 1 lb of crackers 10 = 1/2 lb sugar 15 cts last evening 25
- 9 Bird & Ran were at J. A.'s this evening Jinnie & Jinnie were here. Nice & warm
- 10 Very fine warm day. Pa & all the boys went to the bush. Far came home at noon I had a letter from Sandy. and there
