from Hermittons 21st Raining hard & Wind
Oscar set a Line 22nd Raining & Wind Murre
23rd Leander Hugh Ann Minnie Went to 7 Corington B bought
a Tye 100 of Flour on Credit 2.58 paid Mr Cartneys
what we owed the last time I was up 2.4 Bought 2 Depts
75 cents a pie 1.50 Value 15 John Murchison and Walter's also
here for Cattle Sawing an Elm Boards for Beams Windy
24th St Bartholomew Rained Windy Thunder put some
Boards on the House 25th Windy Laflesh went Back
to Murdoch Mr Donalds at Hay went to Sturgeon Jct
for the saw Hamma axe Tub Leander Found a
Bun Down Below the Nit Kit got 1 lb of Tobacco
from Montreal 18 Campers on Plum Island Left
Narcisse and George Went to Montreal as his Daughter
is getting Married next Week Rained Very
hard to night heavy Lightning Thunder

and his Wife here wanting to sell a Horse 29th
Narcisse came up from the Marriage on Monday
Lathering and the fire spreading out Hay Fine.
St. John Baptiste married 30th Fine Hugh Ann and
Livinia went to see if they were coming with the
Horse They came and took the Oxen Leander not
well Stanley and Lathering Hay the Oxen
horns broke some way to Day they must be fighting
31st Heavy Rain Wind Narcisse got Matched
Tethering the mare Thunder & Lightning
1st of September Fine & Wind Mr Leslie and the Line
the Lawyer here Hunting I treated me to Old Pige
Leander to Summit town Bought of Summers 3 lb
of Nails 15 Bought at Nicholsons 3 Nails 15 got
papers from Murre and in a corner for the
fixing stones under the Foundation of the House
Drove some wood and stones north to the
mare she goes well Houting commences
2nd Fine Jordan Bismarck and Fernandez here
3rd D Mr W. Astors Birth Day 1846 a Fine Day putting in
Hay Took up some of the Lower Point Apples as they are
not gaining much 4th a Fortunate Day began Stack put
in 75 to Day not finished Windy put salt on this stack
put fresh hay on it to night Rained to night Windy
5th John Angles Birth Day 1850 Fine Cold Windy
Cutting hay on the Lower Point 6th Yera here looking
for Timber Finished the stack 3 Tons 120 Cocks in it
7th Fine Day The apples is going off some way
