

Myself cutting logs. Planted some Rhubarb seed
and Black Turnip Radish seed.

Tuesday 24th. Fine warm and sultry. Omitted
on the 24th setting down kneading trough
of 9. Soble not R. Basket of Idem 1. 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ d. Father and (Bred
in the morning) Robert in the afternoon digging potatoes
frustrate on our own place and began on Idem.
Thrashing. Phil pulling up stray twigs betw
Barn logs. Last night set fire to the heaps we raggel
in the winter burning well. sowed half the lettuce
seed sent by Jonathan Coyne.

Wednesday 25th. Cool and dull rain during the
forenoon fine chief part of the afternoon and rain
in the evening. Father and Robert digging potatoes
Bred thrashing. Phil drawing logs for Idem
sky in the morning drawing barn logs in the after-
noon. Myself gardening sowed the long beet seed.

Thursday 26th. Rain all last night till 3 this
morning fine the rest of the day with cold north
wind. Father and Robert chopping in the fore-
noon digging potatoes in the afternoon. Bred
chopping logs about the clearing thrashing in
the afternoon. Phil to father with one logging.
Chopping barn logs myself.

Friday 27th. Frost last night. fine and pleasant
during the day. Father and Robert after potatoes
Bred and Phil chopping up logs and drawing them
together in the clearing. I went to the village. Mond-
ing Mule Idem 1. 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ d. Gallon of oil
1. 6 d. Newspaper 2. 1 d. 4 pounds of coffee 5. 0 d. Pound of
dugar 6 d. 8 pounds of apples at 8 d. = 5. 4 d. 2 lbs of butter
3. 0 d. 4 pounds of pease at 3 d. = 1. 2 d.

Saturday 28th. Dull and cold all day wind east-
erly with rains part of the day. Logging at Idem my
and Phil. Father and Robert after potatoes Robert after
staring part of fence in the morning. Fud over jobs
planted turnip seed in morning and Bred beet and
arrows in afternoon.
