Blisswood which sheared the sheep some
Cold 3rd Ploughed some Rows of Corn. Apples
Old Henry the 3rd Birth Day Went to Ma-
-Rout's Island Randolph and killed a large
Black Snake with a large lizard in his mouth on
Ma-Rout's Island a good many Boats gone,
and towing 5 sections Day. Then V. Hays de
Mr. Davies the fisherman to Lancaster the old
man went to Montreal as his pay did not
come up on the Boat Ploughing the West
side of the Corn (Potatoe Bugs) Plenty
Planted Pease in the old Garden and Beans
keeping in the chens set out the 2 sheep
kept in the Black weather as he is not
smart made a Bridge to night
and fired a Train Valley of West
to night. Killed some Thunder
collecting at Summers is yesterday
evening 6th set the Beech Barrel
for soap. Rain was over around
the Island Windy West West this
morning I am affected with a Malady of 50
Heard 30th George Kenshaw here took
down the old way took my Strainer
with Thomas aurore and Geo
aw.

Working at the Potatoes and Bugs 11th St. Barnabas
Went to Hopkins with Milk Yesterday the
3 of them Gordon Hugh Ann and Randolph
went to Summestown got the Strainer and
2 Doz of Cups and Saucers 40 cents Strainer 25 cents
got Lime from George Bought of J. Summers Soda
5 cents Needles 5 cents got the Dog Snap from
Clemens working on the Roads on the
front of the Mill the Path. Master 12th
Corpus Christi crossed with 28 lbs of Butter
to Mr. Ward Paul for Gordons Boats Bought
3 yds Calico 24 4 yds Cotton 40 2 yds of Overalls 40 Paul 25
Soap 6 Caps 10 got some Hacks and wood at Hamilton
Working at Corn Bugs 13th Cold night with Frosts
most every night 4th 12th Went to the Bush
cut a stick for ears put the Black Weather
Doron in the Bush in the Swamp
Dead a jester day throw of Bees getting
ripe keeping in the hens Beans peeping
up Rohito Bugs Bad 2 taken here yesterday
to get all night Bondell and Johnston
caught a Large Thursday Hamilton
cows eat their Provision Broke their
Rocks and Limes 15th Rainy some Wind
Mr. Gene here long to Cornwall Gordon
went with him. Slept all night here to
Gene went off took a few from the 3 Davelley
the Corn 17th Lots of Mice 18th Waterloo
Gene first time this Spring I went to fish
caught a good many perch, Mr. Tuttle
and Dan Summers here to night had
good many fish. Made hot a pepper
fish and a mustard and vinegar from
Mr. Tuttle. Gordon crossed for Butter tub
5 cents hair pins 5 cents 15th the Cow Blay see
the Gene Cow keeper her in 2nd 11th Gene
Indians for earstiff angus cam
and his Boy here on the 15th
