Practical Points in Infant Feeding—No. 3.

Something should be said regarding the changes required in milk modification during very hot weather. At such times both the proteins and fat must be reduced but particularly the latter. An infant can no more digest a high percentage of fat during hot weather than a soldier in a tropical climate can. It is seldom wise in any case, even of perfectly healthy children, to have the fat in the summer months over 3 per cent, and during short periods of excessive heat it should be reduced to 2 per cent.—*Pediatrics*.
