

Sept 25th / 1892

Continued in the Church until it passed by, and then came home, after arriving home it commenced raining again and kept it up nearly all night. Many Barrels were burned by the lightning on Wolfe Is and elsewhere

Mon 26. Raining mostly all day turning cold at night, some lightning and lightning at night but no rain

Tue 27. Fine and cool partly cloudy, colder at night

Wed 28. Very cold and a heavy frost this morning, clear and fine all day.

Thurs 29. Very fine day, warm and bright, at Mrs Lanes, and Mr & Mrs Hays this evening

Sept 30th / 1892

Fri 30. Very fine this morning partly cloudy this afternoon appearance of rain tonight clearing off latter in the evening and being a very fine moon light night.

Sat. 1. Oct 1st / 1892

Cold but pleasant, a raw west wind blowing most of the day, fine at night.

Sun 2. Beautiful day, was visiting at Mrs Rays to day remained there for dinner and tea, had an enjoyable time, at Church this evening a Miss Barton fainted away, I had just got acquainted with her a few days ago, she looked like a corpse
