the Revd Mr M^r Flury preached in caintown
21 finished the band wheel for the thrashing machin
22 drew some wood in the forenoon & killed the
Bull in the afternoon cold day
23 went to Brockville with some sausages yes
8 per lb & expected to meet Tonney from Pack
but he did not come took 2 barrels of apple
to A Turner 2 dollars per barrel
24 1pm Hazlewood & family was here for dinner
Thomas Stockland got five Sheep on shares newt & 1
lamb of Sises 1 ewe of Yables 1 of Fennets & 1 of
Marry's A little snow to day
25 helped Rob Armstrong at the thrashing
machin went to Lyn & bought 1 side of saddleback
paid 1. 10^{1/2} per lb
- 26 Jack Tonney & Cen. went to Brackville
the boys & me thrashed 4 bushel of wheat &
cleaned it up other took it to mill & 2 bushel
the Rev. M^r Benning preached in cain
town fine day
- 27 28 went to Mr Mansont & to Mr Haugh
for the Sheep those that was at Haugh
& marked with a black stroke of the fore
head paid one shilling per head that is
thrashed the fall oats in the forenoon
31 cleaned the fall oats had 40 bushel
