More rain last night, raining some a.m. cloudy day. We finished cutting the wood pile in yard to-day also load of split cedar stumps brought from behind barn. Willie drove down a.m. got 1 ton of tankage fertilizer out of car shipped to D B Scott, paid him \$37.00 cash for it drew \$40.00 out of his bank acct & got bushel timothy at Simmons \$5.50 bag 25 lbs. 3 gals gasoline \$1.00 also beltline 12 lbs at Nichols. We got 2 stamps from Barbours 2 lbs sent letter to F + I re outwary disk harrow to not sending our harrow. Mrs Barbours over P.M. tell girls about meeting at her place on Thursday. The girls up at Indales at night to see about giving Mrs Barbours a present. Willie went up for them. Mr Leslie's barn on the Farrow farm was burned last night

Misty morning then sunny and warm clouded over by P.M. rained heavy, thunder & lightning. Willie took cow No 2 over to Bowleys again this morning paid him \$2.00. Mr Madric brought over pig crate in stoneboat we took low wagon with dock rack over to other barn put rack and long sleigh in shed of barn then brought load poplar wood from No 6 bush. P.M. Willie drove girls down they went to W.F.M. meeting gave call 75 lbs Mrs Manjes speaker, Willie took cream to station. Bella got patten at Russells 15 lbs they also got on of umbrella, May brought pair gloves as present for Mrs Barbours our share 25 lbs. We cut wood P.M. with circular between chimneys. Willie drove down for girls took wheelbarrow down in buggy. We got Dornhams + Ammons orders all 20th \$240.
