 sawdust for ice houses taking  
 it from Lancaster to Salmon River  
 8<sup>th</sup> Windy cold fine Leander crossed  
 for the mail Bought of A M Donald  
 Broom 20 spool 5 pencil 1 of the  
 crack Bad crossing to Hamilton  
 John and A M Dougall came with  
 the 2 Pots have them the Ham  
 got 2 Books from Hamilton Fine  
 9<sup>th</sup> fine Donald spink here 10<sup>th</sup> drawing  
 wood got a Rat Making troughs  
 11<sup>th</sup> Fernandez came Leander Fernandez  
 went to Mon Dougalls sale Rain  
 sawing stove wood 12<sup>th</sup> on this Day  
 of the month D M Master Semion  
 first came to the Island Peter Buchanan  
 passed here going to Lancaster for  
 2 Loads of Sawdust and its awful  
 foggy Making troughs Raining

 Rain Foggy made some troughs cutting  
 stove wood a Team crossing Summers Road  
 Lots of Ducks Flying  
 12<sup>th</sup> Stanley's Birth Day 1880  
 fine Day Fernandez went off cutting  
 stove wood made some troughs got  
 a Rat 15<sup>th</sup> Blackbirds came fine  
 sent home Lewis Pig Leander  
 crossed Bought of A M Donald  
 5 Doz of Herring 50 Boots for  
 Sonia 90 cents Pepper 1/2 lb 15 cents  
 3/4 of an inch Bit 25 cents 2 Dollars 85 cents  
 Lewis 2 Boys here for smoothing irons  
 brought 32 new troughs ash and  
 soft-maple to the Bush took some of  
 the camp-kigging to the Bush 16<sup>th</sup>  
 fine Gordon and Bismarck Lewis wife  
 and 3 children here got a Dollar from  
 Gordon 17<sup>th</sup> St Patrick's Day The Festival  
 of the Irish a Dance at Hopkins Point to night  
 fine windy some brains snow Northern  
 lights to night cutting brush for the fence  
 cutting wood at the sugar Bush crossing  
 on Summerstown Road with horses  
 18<sup>th</sup> on this Day of the Month Velly  
 departed 1887 Leander and John H went  
 to Hamiltons for oats got 4 Bushels  
 have Tom a Dollar that's 12 Bushels  
 got that's 3<sup>rd</sup> 60 But got 3 Turkeys  
 Making some troughs Sapt for 8 Ines  
 not running well Fixing a floop on the  
 Gene Pot
