Monday

Fine sunny day not very frosty though some in sunshine. I drove down in AM got galvanized iron at at foundry to fit the wooden boiler pot at Merrimac & Co. round axles front 10cts at Carters wheat germ 25cts. In PM we broke a road through drifts to No 2 hauled back 2 small loads manure from cattle stable and put it in heaps like side middle the tree.

Tuesday

Fine sunny day drawing in sunshine frosty a little. Willie drove over to Salem Kate & Joss in sleigh took a buggy out to get quistled. In PM he drove girls down town they got at Christy's groceries 18 Steels groceries 30 Phillips stamps 10 Rounds dry goods 12 Mills meat 25¢ at Steels dry goods \$5.18 I finished sheep rack Willie got at Templeton one of sheet iron which are put on bottom boards then one put the galvanized iron on top of that again.

Cloudy more snow last night east wind thawish a little rain in evening. We set up boiler in kitchen cellar and went in selling 2 pugs today estimated \$18.10
