Monday

Fine sunny day and very frosty. Thawing and in sunshine. I drove down in AM got galvanized iron and at foundry to put the wooden boiler put at Merrim in afternoon. Found nails for 10cts at Carter's wheat grain 25cts. In PM we broke a road through drifts to No 2 hauled back 2 small loads manure from cattle stable and put it in heaps other side middle of the town.

Tuesday

Fine sunny day, thawing in sunshine. frosty a little. Willie drove over to Salem Kate & Jess in sleigh took 3 bags of what to get quilted. In PM he drove girls down town they got at Armstrongs groceries 18 Steals groceries 30 Phillips stamps 10 Russell dry goods 12 Mills meat 25 at Steals dry goods \$5.18 I finished sheep rack Willie got at Dempsters in afternoon sheet iron which one put on bottom boiler then one put the galvanized iron on top of that again.

Cloudy more snow last night east wind thawish a little rain in evening. We set up boiler in kitchen cellar and night in Kelley & pay to-day estimated \$19.00
