 11th Wrote a letter to F. J. I got a card & L. B.
 Norton I went to I got on over at 7.50
 two pairs of boots & a pair of rubbers I got a
 pair of envelopes 10 cts It was a wet day rained
 all day & Billy worked at photo stones until about
 half past three the he started at Wm. Willis's
 job. He paid my for rent to 1st Jan. 1906
 13th paid Will. Johnson for 1760 lbs of
 hay \$5.30 I named all day painted Mrs.
 Ins. at night
 14th I wrote to Mary A. Moulton Wm.
 Poole Wm. Richardson. I went after noon
 fixing him his note is due on the
 15th 10 cts for putty got 15 from Mrs.
 Jas. Denby on Halladay stone &
