Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> fine  
Father Mary, & I went  
to Church in morning  
and, Children to S. S.  
& Mother Jinnie & I in evening

Monday 8<sup>th</sup> fine  
Mr Swayne & an agent came  
out to try a plow Father  
likes it will plow is to be \$42<sup>75</sup>  
and our old gang plow  
to be paid when we try it in  
so, if it suits us, J. Roper  
is setting posts today, he is  
to get, 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cts each and board  
Mr Sharp, came and we  
took a look around the  
stock Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> dull  
we worked at posts in  
fence, and Father plowed  
turnip grounds.

Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> fair  
we worked at fence, J.  
Roper has put in 47 posts  
@, 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cts each, \$5.88, I paid him 588  
Went to Cheltenham, in evening  
had quite a chat with John & family  
& family, and looked at stock  
Ticket \$1.45 145
