Wed Mar 26th the sky hazy high wind from the ~~at~~ East and soft I sat fair to the bark I peled up in the garden and the corn stalks. after noon shelled corn for the chickens

Thu Mar 27th cloudy and warm. I was down to the old home this fore noon Dick was draining out manure. they were boiling sap

Wed Mar 28th a heavy fog in the morning the rest of the drizzling rain. Sarah was here a little while at noon. She got a fall last night and hurt herself

Thu Mar 29th clear part of the day and warm. a heavy rain last night I sat in the house most of the day

Sun Mar 30th East wind until about 4 P M and heavy ^{rough} fore part of the after noon when the wind shifted to the North and it turned cold. Pearl and her man was up from Wallisburg

Mon Mar 31st cloudy wind from the North west and cold I went down to the old home to trim apple trees but the wind was so cold I came back. to day finishes up March most of the month has been fine wether for the time of year

Tue April 1st Snow Shower and soft John B Smary was here part of the after noon

Wed Apr 2nd cloudy misting snow and cold setting in the house most of the day.

Thu Apr 3rd clear part of the day and cold Sarah was here baking bread and cleaning up the house for me Elva Paul came over this fore noon. Thomas Houston was buried this after noon. I did not get over

Fri Apr 4th light cloud and cool. I went down to the old home and trimmed apple trees. not doing much in the after noon
