

Crotton March 1902

Wed Mar 26th the sky hazy high wind from the East and soft & Sat fever to the bark I peeled up in the garden and the corn stalks. after noon shelled corn for the chickens
Thu Mar 27 cloudy & and warm. I was down to the old home this fore noon Dick was draining out manure. they were boiling sap
Mar 28th a heavy fog in the morning the rest of the drizzling rain. Sarah was here a little while at noon. She got a fall last night and hurt herself.
Thu Mar 29 clear part of the day and warm. a heavy rain last night I sat in the house most of the day
Sun Mar 30 East wind would about 4 P.M. and heavy rain part of the afternoon when the wind shifted to the North and it turned cold. Pearl and her man was up from Wallaceburg

Mon

Mar 31st cloudy wind from the North west and cold I went down to the old home to trim apple trees but the wind was so cold I came back. to day finishes up March most of the month has been fine weather for the time of year

Tue

April 1st Snow shower and soft John B Snary was here part of the afternoon

Wed

Apr 2 cloudy misting snow and cold setting in the house most of the day.

Thu

Apr 3 clear part of the day and cold Sarah was here baking bread and cleaning up the house for me Elva Paul came over this fore noon.

Fri

Thomas Huston was buried this afternoon. I didn't get over the 4th light cloud and cool. I went down to the old home and trimmed apple trees. not doing much in the afternoon
