Broke on Stack 3 Tons Fine & thick
 25th Christmas Day Fine not much snow
 the Fields ice pretty well Broke up Freezing
 to night & Wind and the ice making some
 Ice took near morning in some places a great
 many air holes 26th open up from the foot of
 Francis Island the Steamboat Channel Freezed
 Fine L. Virginia turned very sudden sick & we
 changed to West 27th Fine ice making some
 and took through to night Leander got a Rat
 st John the Evangelist Day 28th First cross
 On the ice Leander and I the ice thin first
 time Leander to Summerstown Bought of Ward
 50c 2 cents Bought of Nicholson Rau
 10 acre haydale 10 Bought of J. Summers 1 lb of Je
 45 paid Kaisers 10 paid Raffle 50 paid got a Rat
 down from J. Hamilton 29th Our Angus Berth 2
 crossed got a hole up from J. Hamilton Bo
 15 Dollars of flour from J. Summers
 Tom Jack to take it down to Hamilton
 Bought of Nicholson's 1 pair of overshoe 1.75
 Brought home Nicholsons bag Oil 35 cent
 Busting side of shore 30th Freezing a place
 for the sheep in the shed 2 men crossing
 over to Salmon River Fine ice Breaking
 some to night 31st Last Day of the year &
 Fine commenced to rain ice Breaking all up
 put in all of the rest of the 3 ton stack Leander
 and I tried for Eels got none Leander got a Rat
 1st of January 1886 Fine in the New Year
 the Boys all shooting shot a Duck Leander
 a Rat took in the Honey Bees in then put them
 out West Wind snowed a little 2nd chopping in
 oak Field Leander got a House Rat in his boat
 ice going down seen a Boat fishing Eels

Wind seen a Monk track chopping stone wood
Cause warm cattle heavy 9th Wind Drifting
Stormy snowing seen a fox on the ice I think
the ice must be taken steamboat channel
from late last night snow banks 10th Sunday
Wind drifting air-holes smoking 11th Wind cold frosty
John H and I to the Pitt Point set a trap for the mink
and I to the Head of the Island to see how the
ice looked a great many air-holes seen a Monk track
quite fresh Lots of Fox tracks ice looks rough frosty
night 12th New years old style chopping stone wood
Wind a very frosty day the frostiest I think
we had yet air-holes smoking water raising
near shore 13th First crossing on the ice as the first ice
I broke up Bought of Summers 1 lb of Tea 45
Adway RR 25 paid this Bought of Mc Holland Boots 75
singers paid 5 lb Tea 25 ale paid Bought of Mr Ward Plum 3
orange colouring 10 paid 14th Broke on the 4th on stack
ice Bushing the Road Fine Day 15th Drawn
wood got a mink fine & wind 16th Fine &
ices in Dundee seen a Weasel Track on
the road ^{or} snow
