Fine East Wind and changed to West commenced snow kind of soft water raining close to Shore drew up the Bins and turned them over so on Ducks flying about large on hole Before the Door Windy night to night Drifting and Frosty

29th Our Angus Birth 2nd Day Windy Frosty Drifting Reading papers a Mock Sun on the East side of the sun 3rd splitting stove - West wind Frosty & frosty night 2 Mock suns 31st Brkhe on a 3 Ton sled to Day East Wind Frosty cold Slush crossing Summers town Road on the ice Feeding the cattle extra last day of the year.

1st of January New Years Day 1888

Sunday a Fortunate Day Windy turned fine Fernandez went off we did not know he went 2nd sold some Solomay and Amiot her took their dinner there at Fishing Els in the mud got 6 from them Brought our Sam home gave him a key to fire of my chest

3rd Allens Birth Day Leander crossed to Summ Bought of I Summers 1853 Tea 57 Needles 5 Thread BB 7 M Ward camp shor 5 Sweetys Heard that Mr Stillwell left the place Franky Leplante seen Fernandez in the gone got an almanack got a letter from D A in it and a Christmas card not very well Bad with Rheumatism Teams crossing now 4th a fine day & UV a great many fishing & Leander and John fishing Els got 9
