A little rain in morning Jack Crabbe who was going to Gulf with load hay turned back and came in here but went away again when rain stopped cleared off mostly sunny.

Willie went down town in morning to see about shipping turnips got at Mills meat 30 at Nichols shove 75 cts I trimmed some turnips and helped make turnip box. In PM Mr Linn came over we trimmed two loads turnips Willie took one down 22 bushels brought from Wilsons Mill with flour \$4.75 then we got the other load in. Mrs Linn called on girls this afternoon. Butter money 44 Mary down town in AM got at Russells butter crock 30 cts and Bellis hat at Miss Boutwinn \$4.75
