Present Management of Syphilis.

C. M. Williams says that every case, especially in the early stages, when the chance of complete recovery is best, should be treated with both salvarsan and mercury, unless there is some special contraindication to one drug or the other; and treatment should be continued in courses of from four to seven weeks, with intervals of about six weeks, until all symptoms have disappeared and the Wassermann reaction is negative.—*Med. Record.*
