 then plowed corn land across from 3 horses  
 where I had feared out with team I also made  
 8 drills for potatoes in orchard. I ditched  
 orchard A.M. Quarric calved to-night calf dead.

## Tuesday

Very hard frost last night ice on water some  
 places cloudy A M cleared off P M sunny.  
 cool day cold A M. We spread one load  
 manure on sod corn land from yard and 4  
 from small pile finishing the pile. then spread  
 3 loads from big pile in field A.M. Adam  
 Armstrong and E. Rickal up in morning as we  
 were at our breakfast canvassing for  
 general fund of church. We promised \$2.30  
 each to church and missions and gave \$1.00  
 extra to C. D. M. Bob Simole came  
 down after dinner got two bags Cornnet  
 potatoes \$1.00 Willie drove down town  
 in waggon P M got tooth attended to at Brothers  
 took 12 doz eggs to F & S. and got bushels  
 corn for feed on dfr. I planted 3 1/2 rows  
 potatoes in new orchard Cornnet. planted  
 some Early Irish Cobbler 2nd row N W of Delicious  
 tree starting from S.W. end of row running to Delicious  
 apple trees. I dug hole near driving shed to bury  
 broken crockery tin inside in. put some in. Mary walked  
 down home at night. Mr Day of Day Bros  
 R R No 4 Guilford in at night to see about draining our
