Wright and Woods in trying to buy Jess offered \$140.00. Bella and Willie went down at night in cutter Willie got at Phillips converse saddle 5 at Russell's Braird 5 cts. Bella stayed down

Christmas Mild mostly cloudy. We went down home in cutter with Jess for dinner. Drove Jim there. P.M. Mr Wright and Mr Clark jeweler came in to see Jess again Willie drove farmer down with him and brought up the girls.

Stormy through night cloudy not very frosty. Willie went to Mrs Cooper with Mand and Lucy got 10 bushels buckwheat \$5.00. P.M. he took 1255 lbs pig chop to Wilson 62 cts I went down with him got took filled at Reids on ice I got from Mr Hardy \$4.30 for wire sold in April. I went down at night got at Darys stamps postcards 15 with 25 Rec from Dr Armstrong for hay \$12.18 paid for ice to date \$8.00
