Edith Dix then Bella and she called on Mrs Wilne at hospital. They paid Uncle Jim \$2.00 for work on docks last year. Received butter cheque \$19.94

Raining nearly all day. I took down 6 frogs to Carter weight 106 lbs @ \$5.10 per cut \$54.05 got \$1.00 to and one from last shipment. weighing 12 I brought up crops Willie took to Carl's Saturday \$5 Father up in morning sent letter down with Jim addressed to G.M.C.A. with 50 cts enclosed. In P.M. we took out of hay and put them on thrashing floor now.
