Womans meeting in vestry 7 members present
my offering 50 cts. There are droves of misquitos
they are on the cows, and by the creek.
Murdy got home about 7 P.M
- 6 Jimmie got 50¢ pig money Gave him 2.75
Marion 1.75 Murdy one to send to Toronto
Pa got the last one 6.25 in all
Pa rented the village farm to Ferguson
