

Functional Neurotic Disorders.

Neurasthenia, nervous "breakdown," nervous prostration, "brain-fag" and allied states are usually but neurotic manifestations of some constitutional metabolic fault, which must be sought out and remedied if intelligent therapy is to be applied. Among the various pathologic conditions which oppose the relief of neural disorders, anemia, whether primary or secondary, is always worthy of therapeutic attention. Unless the blood supply is relatively normal in both quantity and integrity, its oxygen-carrying capacity is "below par" and, consequently, metabolic exchange and interchange is embarrassed and the necessary improvement in bodily nutrition is difficult of accomplishment. **Pepto-Mangan (Gude)** stimulates and encourages oxygenation and nutrition, by furnishing the more or less impoverished blood with an immediately appropriable form of its vital metallic elements, iron and manganese. The vital stimulus thus imparted is often the one thing needful to initiate the substantial systemic "building up" process which must precede the desired recovery from neurotic disorders.
