Willie took rest of cement also tools etc down to Joe Malerba AM paid him in full for cement $3\frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{8}$ bbls @ \$1.70 per bbl \$6.15. Then brought load manure from 7 tracks we spread it in field also 3 loads from field pile to manure stack corner enough to let us plow. We plowed some rounds with Joss & Lucy. Father up for tea. Willie drove him down in evening. Wm. Clark up for eggs 2 doz 34 Ken Gass over at night for milk 5 qts Charlie Robb in AM collecting for Mr. Barber who was burnt out last week. We gave \$2.00

Frost last night again not quite so hard as usual. mostly fine sunny day cloudy over in PM and a few drops drizzling. We cleaned pig pen took back load on speckle to No 7 then spread 6 or small loads from field pile. PM I finished sowing oats 7 I except small patch too wet and Willie harrowed it ahead of me. Mrs Ritchie up for tea. Mary down to W.F.M.S. in PM collection 10 groceries 27 Sold Beatty Stock 4 hours at 2cts \$2.15. Mary got meat Hartman's 50

PM we sowed barley in No 2 most wheat dry top sowed down. Mary down PM got 2 Phillips Adolphus \$1.25 goats at 6cts 65cts. Strong East wind all PM. Mary down getting her horses fitted.
