Willie took rest of cement also took etc down to Geo Malcolin A.M. paid him in full for cement $3\frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{8}$ bbls @ \$1.70 for 6.15. Then brought load manure from 7 tracks to pile. I worked at henhouse window. P.M. Willie brought up another load manure from 7 tracks we spread it ahead also 3 loads from field pile to manure dealer corner enough to let us plow. We plowed some rounds with Jess & Lucy. Father up for tea Willie drove him down in evening. W... Clark up for eggs & doz 34 Hen Gass over at night for milk sets Charlie Robb in A.M. collecting for Mr Barber who was burnt out last week Wagon \$2.00
