Fine sunny day. We sowed hammond  
 and sowed some more of No 5 today while  
 the oats signs leaving strips across field in water  
 but nearest bottom end hard to work yet. Girls down  
 town PM got at Stubs goods in dept \$2.88. I  
 went down at night got at Woods 2 collars & ties  
 Uncle Jim Paulin died today. Bread 5/2

Sunday

Fine day mostly: bank clouds passing some  
 clouds and a shower. We were preceded  
 AM from Mark and in evening from  
 Mark favorable of the growing grain. Only  
 Willidom in morning. Bella and I down at night.  
 Willie and Mary drove up to Aithen to see Aunt  
 Carrie and remains of uncle Jim. Jess in buggy.  
 Took floral wreath got at Bonobas got back between 7 & 8.

Very fine day warm sun and breeze. Bella  
 Mother & I drove to Aithen to Uncle Jim funeral today in rig  
 got from Currier's house & rig cost \$2.00. Willie cultivated  
 disked some No 5 AM as in 1st part of pea land No 7  
 steam field. Kate had a foal this morning when Willie  
 went out in morning fully. We put cows out to grass at time today also  
 Peter & Lucy off at night. 7 other up PM. He and another  
 drove down with the Currier rig at night. Spilled milk and oil yet.
