snow nearly all gone got frost by night.
We trimmed and piled rest of poplars we cut

yesterday.

22 Thursday
Frosty to-day not very cold cloudy. We
brought over load hay in AM and in PM
stretched wire on gate frame. Mary down

Lucy. Mary got tooth fixed. They bought at Russells
dress \$2.00 at Steels goods \$2.36, Got butter
money P. B. Co. 13:44 from M. Q. also 36 cts from
Mrs Smith for straw \$3.00 for rays horse skin rubber etc
45 cts meat to 7 other 1.75 - Gave order to
two men for map of Canada to be delivered here at 8 cts
