May drove town PM saw Jim Beattie and Wilson about the will etc. she got hooks & eyes at Russells 10 ds pair Mrs Barty \$4.25 for dress making.

Fine sunny day not warm very windy. we cut wheat No 6 below other barn and brought in load barley AM. PM we brought in rest of barley 2 1/2 loads also 1 1/2 loads of No 3 oats. Willie drove May down at night she stayed down. Willie got at 7 o'clock 28 ds forgot to bring it up. Caught mixture for Maud at Phillips \$1.25 hair cut 20 ds. at 7 & 8 3 bags purity flour \$10.45 1 bag bran \$1.30 took 10 day eggs @ 24 ds \$2.40 also paid old age \$4.50 didn't get the age see about it.
