

Camden Gore February 1884

Fri Feb 8th cloudy set in the morning. I was hanging up some pork this fore noon after noon putting straw in the old barn. John took catharine home

Sat Feb 9th cloudy and moderate was putting straw in the barn. Anne not much better

Sun Feb 10th cloudy and cool

Mon Feb 11th cloudy and soft. Some rain this after noon. I took a load of barley and peas to Dresden mill and got chopt. Anne a little better.

Tue Feb 12th a rain and freeze all day. not doing a great deal to day. was over seeing Old Mr Lampman he is pretty low

Wed Feb 13th cloudy and soft. the snow pretty much gone. I was helping to layout old Mr Lampman this fore noon. he died this morning. after noon splitting stove wood very heavy rain last night and raining again to night

Thu Feb 14th cloudy high wind from the south west and cold. rain the fore part of last night latter part snow. this fore part of the day I was thrashing out peas. after noon paul beaver for Old Mr Lampman

Fri Feb 15th cloudy and cold. I was thrashing out peas most of the day. this evening went to for the & groceries I ordered through the Grange

Camden Gore February 1884

Sat Feb 16th cloudy and moderate. I finished thrashing the peas this fore noon the rest of the day we were sawing stove wood. Anne a little better

Sun Feb 17th cloudy and soft some rain.

Mon Feb 18th cloudy and soft. was cleaning peas and carrying in straw to day

Tue Feb 19th cloudy and quite warm. rain this evening. we were Butchering pigs Billton Snarey & William Book helping me. Anne a little better. I heard blue birds and saw a crow the first for this season.

Wed Feb 20th flying clouds and cold raw wind. took a load of pork to Dresden and sold to John Green & Ira Simpson for eight Dollars per hundred pounds. Anne not so well to day.

Thu Feb 21st cloudy high cold wind. went up to Florence to day

Fri Feb 22nd cloudy and cold some snow. not doing much to day

Sat Feb 23rd cloudy some snow. went with Fred Snarey to Thamesville this after noon

Sun Feb 24th cloudy some snow

Mon Feb 25th cloudy and soft snow most of the day was splitting stove wood and cleaning up a load of barley and peas to get chopt
