3 A & Henry drove down & straightened posts  
south of Gray's & out near 11<sup>th</sup> P.M. A.M.  
they pulled down & rebuilt rail fence  
from corner of 11<sup>th</sup> to the bush P.M.  
I took our horses Chief & Billy & Thomas  
Spring Wagon & he & Thomas & Benj's went  
to Stauffer's I got 4 Truck Tires for  
\$1.50 Cents. W. very fine & clear

Mouth & got 500 Bricks at Cherrywood  
\$2.00 per M. Henry sheared the sheep

5 I brought road scraper from Nick Reasor.  
Henry helped awhile at Benj's at stable  
A laid some floor in Old Hog pen. A.M.

& a piece of Oren & they cut some feed  
P.M. W. very fine & clear. I & Henry Ann  
& Devaran went to Binlan Esos Horse  
they were not at home then we went  
to Binlan Peter's to dinner  
6 Herman's & Binlan Peter's came this morning  
A hitched our horses to Herman's Spring Wagon  
& Mary & Annie went along too they went to  
mouth of Range fishing. They did not catch  
Mary & I & Henry helped Glavin clean some  
blocks of timber from bush to the barn. A.M.  
they chanced P.M. I took Butter & Egg to  
Loutier. A.M. W. wind & haze. A.M. Clear  
P.M. Herman's & Peter's were here to supper  
I & Henry helped Casper's at Glavin  
I scraped some Manure & went to Union  
ville for his road. A.M. P.M. I went to Coles  
A.M. W. very fine getting cooler
