Mon Jan 20th clear and pleasant. I attended the institute meeting this afternoon and tea meeting at night

Tue Jan 21st cloudy some snow and moderate not doing much myself. John Farler was here last night and this fore noon

Wed Jan 22nd cloudy windy day. I split wood in the Shop

Thu Jan 23rd cloudy and cool. I was splitting wood Dick bought three lodes of wood

Fri Jan 24th cloudy and moderate. I split wood for the stove part of the day

Sat Jan 25th clear and pleasant. not doing much

Sun Jan 26th a cloudy foggy cloudy soft day

Mon Jan 27th light cloud high wind from the North West and cold.

Tue Jan 28th clear and cold. was sitting by the stove

Wed Jan 29th cloudy and cold. not doing anything myself. He was here

Thu Jan 30th clear and mild. I was splitting stove wood part of the day. Chester Silary's boy died this morning

Fri Jan 31st cloudy and creeping snow all day. not doing much myself. was splitting some stove wood for Mr McCome he and his daughter being down with the mumps

Sat Feb 1st cloudy and soft I went over to see John B Snarey who is down sick with mumps. Chester Snary's boy was buried this day

Sun Feb 2nd snow last night and this fore noon after noon high wind from the west and blustering snow drifting

Mon Feb 3rd cloudy part of the day and cold was doing a few chores for myself and neighbours who are down with mumps

Tue Feb 4th a cold blustering stormy day Old Mr Greenwood was buried this afternoon

Wed Feb 5th clear and cold 4 deg below zero this morning not doing much splitting wood
