- 1 Wednesday. I did not go to prayer meeting.

- 2 Woman's Meeting at A. C. M. S. I did not go
- 3 I was washing for three days. Far went to Lunenburg
- 4 Oliver Collet paid B. 2.50.
- 5 Mr Given not here Mr McKay, of Summerstown
preached at. M. & P. M. Hatty was here over night.
- 6 Monday. Jimmie began to plough on village farm
Sable stepped on a long stick and one end of
it sprung up and struck in her belly. By
the saddle four inches deep. paid Willie the B. 20⁰⁰
Jack Sullivan paid Pa 20⁰⁰ for Russels Rent -
got seeds. Mangolds, beets & carrots onions 38 cts
- 7 Far came home last evening and went off again
he was going to Wales on the 10.30. Sowed 1 sq in garden
- 8 Finley was to see Sable today. Jimmie ploughing
sowed Mangolds, beets, long & short. Carrots, red & white
Yesterday & today were very fine. Mosquitoes here
- 9 I was not in prayer meeting ~~this evening~~.
- 10 Fine day. Jimmie ploughing. Murdy sowed
a little in the garden sowed 16 beets
- 11 Mrs Richardson sent strawberry plants
- 12 I planted the strawberries and a few potato
- 13 Far came home last night. Cousin Far
drove him over. He went off tonight.
Professor Ross, preached this morning
- 14 Primary meeting tonight McKay & Mc
Tiver addressed the meeting they propose
going to China
- 15 A meeting of the congregation called for
today and but 12 responded. It rained
all afternoon.
- 16 Quite cool today sent a parcel to Far
by express paid Baggaly 16.
