preached at A. M. & P. M. Hatty was here over night
6 Monday. Jimie began to plough on village farm
Table stepped on a long stick and one end of
it sprung up and stuck in her belly. by
theudder four inches deep paid Willi the \$20⁰⁰
Jack Sullivan paid Pa 20⁰⁰ for Russel's Rent
got seeds. Mangolds, beets & carrots onions 38cts 38
- Far came home last evening and went off again
he was going to Wales on the 10.30. Sowed 15q in garden
- 7 Finley was to see Table today. Jimie ploughing
sowed Mangolds, beets, long & short, carrots red & white
Yesterday & today were very fine. Mosquitoes here
- 8 I was not in prayer meeting ~~this evening~~
- 9 Fine day. Jimie ploughing. Murdy stayed
a little in the garden sowed 15~~beets~~
- 10 Mrs Richardson sent strawberry plants
- 11 I planted the strawberries and a few potatoe
- 12 Far came home last night. Cousin Far
drove him over, he went off tonight
Reverend Ross preached this morning
- 13 Improvement meeting tonight Mr King & Mr C
Kier addressed the meeting they purpose
going to China
14. A meeting of the congregation called for
today and but it suspended it round
all afternoon.
- 15 Quilt. wool today sent a parcel to Far
by express from Ballygally 15.
