- 19 To 24 butter 45^{cts} want tent caterpillars 45
- 20 Fine cool day. We washed the plaster of the dining room
- 21 Cool day I washed. Got 1 lb tea at D.D. McDonalds 35
- 22 Fine day
- 23 Warm day I sowed beans 1 row. To 4 yds white cotton 7^{cts} = 28. 1 spool thread 5 33
- 24 Major Army in afternoon
- 24 Fine day. Murdy got stuff to make a plug, red cotton and a jack
- 25 Fine warm day. Murdy went to Green Valley. Sent for white goods to L. Eatons
- 26 Major came back today, is putting the culvert through the field. Gave Whitford 12 bush pellets or cuts To 1/2 gallon oil 25. Salt 5 - 3 yds chuse cloth 15. Mosquitoes came yesterday.
- 27 Hot day. Bitters very dust
- 28 Dull day. cold wind. Bird sowed flowers. Our folk sowed 13 bush oats behind the free church
- 29 Fine day plenty of mosquitos. Got the white goods from Eatons, very satisfactory. They had W. Killimare for a while, coming
- 30 Fine growing day. Cloudy, one light shower. To 3 lb steak 30. Sent 1/2 to Eatons for a few things. Dr. McJannet was shown & took tea up with him. John McTherson (nurse) had one hand taken off yesterday, it had some coc on it. Dr. Maud McJannet operated, sowed 13 bush today 10 yds today
- 31 Very fine day sowed today

June 1900

- 1 Friday. 10 A.M. Rain To sugar 50. 50
- 2 sowed 23 bush oats gave Killimare 50. 50
- 2 Began to rain early in the morning, and rained all day. The creek is full to the bridges, and our meadow is overflowed To 2 bottle 47^{cts} 47
- 3 Rained through the morning, now 2. P.M. Sun out and wind high. Rev. P. Watson preached in St. Andrew's. Mr. Guin went to attend the funeral of his mother
- 4 Fine day
- 5 News of the surrender of Victoria. Transvaal Paid 30^{cts} for last week's stock, and 32 for stew 62
- 6 Our village indulged in fire work last night, and they had some very good speeches To 1 lb tea 30, 3 3/4 yds flannellet 7 24. Cold 42. 77
- eggs, 1^{ct} a piece. Corn brush 10, bush brick 5 15
- eye 10. Lamp chimney 5 15
- 7 Returned the flannellet. We set sleeve buttons 25 25
- peppermints 5. Sugar 25. starch 10
- Bird & I went to Lancaster to the U. F. M. S. this afternoon. A fine number of delegates. Got at Whitford 1 doz bananas 25 - 1/2 doz Lemons 10 35
- 8 Paid Provan for honey. Received some time ago 30
- and got 18^{cts} worth today. To 1/2 gallon molasses 30
- 2 lbs B. sugar 10. Kirchief from Syrian woman 11
- 3 bone hair pins 5
- 9 Fine day. Bird & Murdy went to the top of the picnic to Hamilton's. I baked dinner and bread. To pan sweet 25. To 3 lbs sausage 30
- 10 A large congregation. Mosquitoes worse this year than for years. 45
- 11 Birdie working at Massena dress.
- 12 Bird washed & churned. Murdy got the last of the auto sowed on well sown furrow, had to be working downy. 50
